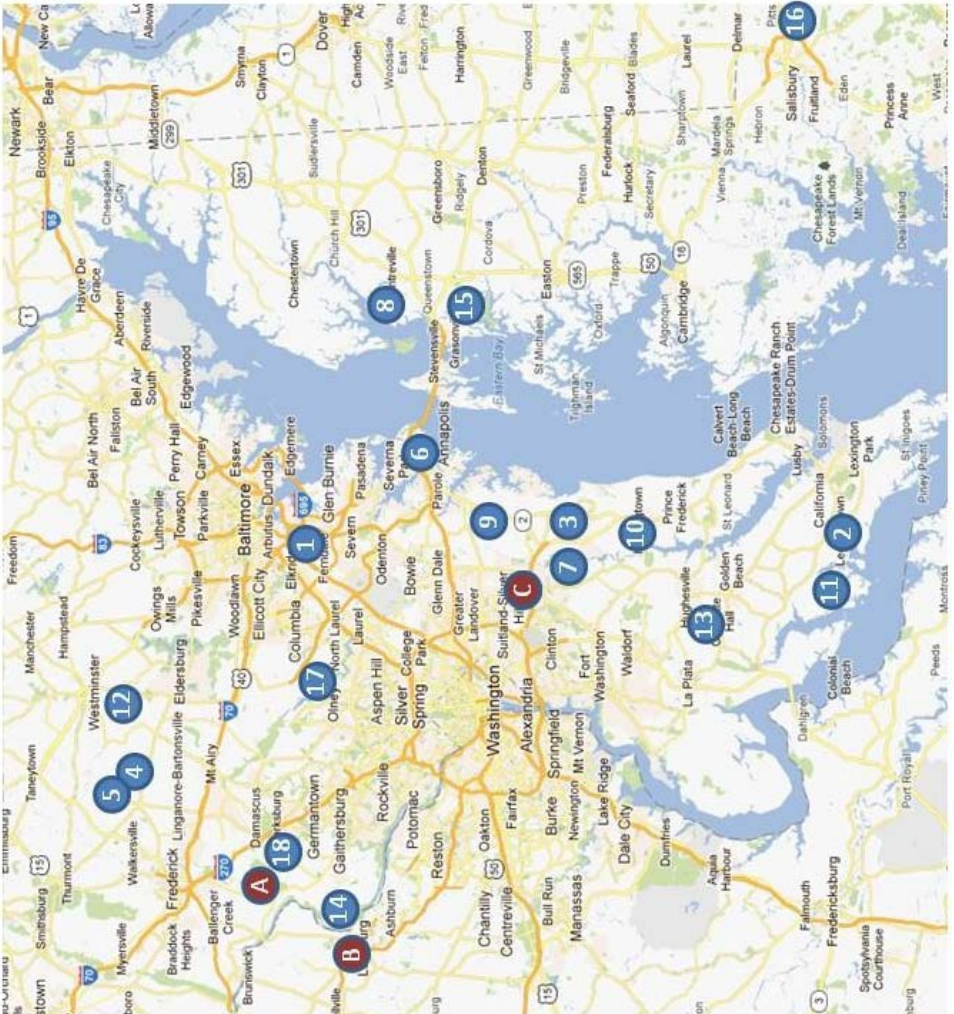

PVDA SHOW AWARDS

PVDA Year-End High Score Awards

General Information:

1. **Definition:** PVDA Year End High Score Awards are awarded to **horse/rider combinations** at the Annual Meeting and Awards Banquet held at the end of the show season.
2. **Eligibility Dates:** The competition year ends October 31 of each calendar year - scores become final on October 31. Any show scores after that date will count towards the following year.
3. **High Scores:** High score awards become final on November 30 of each calendar year. No additional scores may be submitted and placings are final.
4. **Levels:** See the PVDA Year End Award Categories Table for details.
5. **Scores That Do and Do Not Qualify:**
 - **Scores that do qualify:** Dressage scores from PVDA Schooling Shows and PVDA-sponsored USEF licensed / USDF recognized shows, non-PVDA sponsored USEF licensed / USDF recognized shows and USEA recognized shows.
 - **Scores that do not qualify:** Dressage scores from PVDA Chapter Schooling Shows, other schooling shows, Chapter Challenge, Region 1 Junior/Young Rider and Adult Team Competition classes which are not USEF licensed / USDF recognized. Introductory Level and Opportunity classes held during USEF licensed / USDF recognized shows do not qualify.
6. **How to Submit Scores:**
 - **PVDA-sponsored schooling shows and PVDA-sponsored USEF Licensed / USDF Recognized shows:** Scores will automatically be included in the calculation. However it is the riders's responsibility to ensure the correct information has been provided to the PVDA High Score Coordinator by emailing HighScores@PVDA.org or via snail mail. Use of the Year End Award Application Form is encouraged, but not required.
 - **Non-PVDA USEF Licensed / USDF Recognized dressage shows and USEA Recognized shows:** Mail the Year End Award Application Form, with test sheet copies, to the PVDA High Scores Coordinator. Email applications may be accepted at the discretion of the Coordinator.
7. **Repeat Winners:** For USDF Introductory through USEF Fourth levels and USEA Beginner Novice through Preliminary tests, once a horse/rider combination wins a first place award in any division, that horse/rider combination is no longer eligible to win any award at that level. For FEI tests, USDF musical freestyles, FEI musical freestyles, Dressage Seat Equitation, USDF Pas de Deux, Quadrille, and USEA Intermediate and Advanced, a horse/rider combination may win or place more than one time.
8. **Splitting/Combining Levels and Divisions:** PVDA reserves the right to split or combine levels and divisions.

Eligibility Requirements: To be eligible for a year-end high score award, a competitor must:

1. **PVDA Member:** Be a PVDA member in good standing.
2. **Minimum Average Score:** Have a final average score of 55.000% or higher (USDF and USEF Dressage Tests) or 45 penalty points or lower (USEA Eventing Tests). For dressage and eventing tests, the highest and lowest scores are dropped. All scores count for musical freestyles, Pas de Deux, Quadrille and Dressage Seat Equitation. For Dressage Seat Equitation points will be awarded for first through sixth place (7, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1 respectively). No minimum number of rides are required. The rider with the highest point total will be declared the winner.
3. **Volunteer Hours:** At least **8 hours** of volunteer work to PVDA during the current show year.
 - **Hours that can be used:** Volunteer hours performed at, or in support of, PVDA schooling shows or PVDA-sponsored licensed/recognized shows by the rider and/or the rider's immediate family members.
 - **Hours that cannot be used:** Volunteer hours performed at chapter or other schooling shows and at non-PVDA licensed/recognized shows and hours performed by the rider's friends or distant relatives.
 - It is the rider's responsibility to ensure volunteer hours have been accurately reported to the High Scores Coordinator.

Definitions:

- **Junior < 10 years:** A junior rider under the age of 10 at the start of the competition year.
- **Junior Rider:** A rider age 17 years or younger at the start of the competition year.
- **Young Rider:** A rider age 18 through 21 years at the start of the competition year.
- **JYR:** A Junior Rider or a Young Rider.
- **Senior Rider:** A rider aged 22 or older at the start of the competition year. Can be an Adult Amateur or Professional.
- **Adult Amateur (AA) Rider:** A rider aged 22 or older that conforms with USEF GR1306 throughout the entire competition year.
- **Professional Rider:** A rider aged 22 or older that is not and Adult Amateur, as defined in USEF GR1306, during any part of the competition year.

PVDA Special Year-End Trophies and Awards

Eastern Shore Chapter Perpetual Trophy

This trophy is awarded at the Annual Meeting and Awards Banquet. It is awarded to the horse/rider combination (Junior or Senior) with the highest average in the Year-End High Score Award program in Training Level meeting the following requirements:

- Neither horse nor rider has ever won more than 3 blue ribbons at any recognized competition.
- Neither horse nor rider has ever competed above First Level in a recognized competition.
- Winner may not be a previous recipient of this trophy

Trespassers William Perpetual Trophy

This trophy is awarded at the Annual Meeting and Awards Banquet. It is awarded to the horse/rider combination (Junior or Senior) with the highest average USDF First through Fourth Level or PVDA Training Level Musical Freestyle score at PVDA Schooling Shows.

Equiery Perpetual Dressage Award

The Equiery sponsors an annual year-end award for the high point Maryland-resident amateur rider at Third Level or above, with a minimum score of 50%, who has shown in at least half of the Maryland-located or PVDA-sponsored U.S. Equestrian Federation/U.S. Dressage Federation licensed shows. The award is presented at the annual PVDA banquet. The winner of this award will:

- Be featured on the cover of The Equiery's annual dressage issue;
- Have a brief feature article appear in the issue which will then be archived on equiery.com with a link to pvda.org;
- Receive a "keeper" trophy and cooler;
- Have his or her name included on the perpetual trophy

PVDA Recognized Show Awards (Spring Show Only)

Doris Schadt Memorial Perpetual Trophy

Awarded at the Annual Meeting and Awards Banquet to the PVDA Junior or Young Rider with the highest percentage score at First Level (excluding Freestyle).

June Robinson Memorial Perpetual Trophy

Awarded at the Annual Meeting and Awards Banquet to the PVDA Junior or Young Rider with the highest percentage score at Second Level (excluding Freestyle)

PVDA Chapter Challenge Awards

Perpetual Trophies

Awarded at the Annual Meeting and Awards Banquet. Trophies are awarded to the Chapter with the highest team score in the following classes:

- USDF Intro Level B
- USDF Intro Level C
- USEF Training Level 2
- USEF Training Level 3
- USEF First Level 2
- USEF First Level 3
- USEF Second Level and Above
- Quadrille and Pas De Deux
- Musical Freestyle

Liz Pritchard Memorial Trophy

Awarded at the Annual Meeting and Awards Banquet to the rider with the highest score in a Training Level challenge class.

PVDA Year-End Breed Awards

The Maryland State Quarter Horse Annual Outreach Award

Awarded to the horse and rider in a recognized or schooling show who receives the highest test score during the competition season. Two awards will be given, one to the highest score in a PVDA recognized show and the other to the highest score in a PVDA schooling show. The same horse/rider combination may not win both awards. To qualify for this award, the horse must be a properly registered Quarter Horse, the score must be received during the competition season, and the rider must be a member of PVDA. If you are interested in competing for this award, send a copy of your American Quarter Horse Association registration for your horse and a copy of the test that earned you your highest score this season, with your name, address, and phone number, to: Eileen Simpson, 18160 Rolling Meadow Way, Olney, MD 20832. The German Oldenburg Verband/Oldenburg Horse Breeders Society High Score Schooling Show Award

Awarded to the horse and rider in a PVDA schooling show who receives the highest average of three test scores during the competition season. To qualify for this award, the horse must be a properly registered GOV/OHBS horse, the score must be received during the current competition season, and the rider must be a member of PVDA. If you are interested in competing for this award, please send a copy of your GOV/OHBS registration for your horse and a copy of the tests that earned you your three highest scores this season, with your name, address, and phone number, to: Marne Martin-Tucker, 7401 Morgan Road, Woodbine, MD, 21797 or e-mail marnemt@aol.com. The deadline to qualify is September 30 of the competition year.

The American Hanoverian Society High Score Schooling Show Award

Awarded to the horse and rider in PVDA schooling shows who receive the highest average of three test scores during the current competition season. To qualify for this award, the horse must be a properly registered AHS horse, the score must be received during the competition season, and the rider must be a member of PVDA. If you are interested in competing for this award, please send a copy of your AHS registration for your horse and a copy of the tests that earned you your three highest scores this season, with your name, address, and phone number, to: Pat Limage, 7511 Old Carolina Road, Gainesville, VA 20155. Phone: 703-754-7555. Email: BaePrid@erols.com. The deadline to qualify is September 30 of the competition year.

PVDA Rider Achievement Awards

PVDA's Rider Achievement Program recognizes rider scores earned at either schooling or recognized shows, with attractive pins for each of four levels. There are separate awards for schooling and recognized show scores. For the schooling show awards, scores must be earned at PVDA schooling shows (not chapter shows). For the recognized show award program, scores can come from any recognized dressage show. In either program, 4 scores are required at the level as follows: USDF Intro 65%, Training Level 63%, First Level 62%, Second Level and above 60%. You can take as long as you like to earn the award(s), ride different horses, and can earn awards at as many levels as you like, as long as you are a PVDA member at the time the score was earned. Full details are below.

- PVDA Rider Achievement awards are given to riders who achieve qualifying scores at Introductory Level, Training Level, First Level, Second Level, Third Level and Fourth Level.
- Separate awards will be given for scores earned at schooling shows and at recognized shows. The Rider Achievement award may be earned once per level per rider for schooling shows, and once per level per rider for recognized shows. This is a rider award. Scores received with different horses may be submitted (different horses, same rider).
- Scores from PVDA schooling shows or from any recognized dressage show may be used. For each level, four scores must be submitted. The scores must have been earned under at least three different judges and from at least two different shows. All scores must be from at least an "L" GRAD in order to qualify.

- Qualifying scores are as follows:
 - USDF Introductory Level - 65%
 - USEF Training Level - 63%
 - USEF First Level - 62%
 - USEF Second Level and Above - 60%
- All scores must be earned subsequent to the program start date of January 1, 2005. Scores from several different competitive years may be used, as long as the rider was a paid PVDA member in good standing at the time the score was earned. If a rider joins PVDA midway through the year, any scores earned previous to his or her membership date (or during a lapsed period of membership) will NOT be considered qualifying scores.
- The rider/member is solely responsible for reporting these scores to the awards chairperson. Scores must be reported by sending a Rider Achievement Award Score Report form plus a copy of the test (don't send original tests please). Riders are encouraged to collect all scores for a given competition year and then send their tests and Score Report Form. PLEASE NOTE: you may collect scores over as many years as you wish, but in order to facilitate verifying that you were a member when the scores were earned, you need to send in each year's scores at the end of that year. For score submission form (PDF format) visit the PVDA website, click on Programs, then click on Awards.

SCHOOLING SHOWS – GENERAL INFORMATION

PVDA Schooling Show Rules

- 1. Eligibility:** PVDA schooling shows are only open to current PVDA members. Mailed entries must include a copy of your PVDA membership card and be certified with member/guardian signature to be accepted. (Check www.pvda.org or contact Membership Chairperson Michele Wellman at membership@pvda.org if you have questions about your membership status.) If a mailed entry is received without a copy of the membership card, the card or a printout from the web site must be presented to the Schooling Show manager on the day of the show or the member will not be permitted to ride. There are no exceptions to this rule.
- 2. Tests:** All Schooling Shows offer current USDF (Intro Level), USEF (Training through 4th Levels), and FEI (PSG through Grand Prix) classes, as well as USEF Dressage Seat Equitation, PVDA Training Level Musical Freestyle, USDF and FEI Musical Freestyles, USDF Pas de Deux, and USDF Quadrille. New for 2012, PVDA will offer all the USEA Eventing Tests from Beginner Novice through Advanced. Riders are responsible for providing all necessary musical equipment. The Pas de Deux and Quadrille tests may be ridden with or without music. See www.PVDA.org > Show Information > Dressage Tests on the left hand menu for these tests. Special tests (i.e., Gaited Horse, Pony Club tests) may be ridden hors concours (score does not count toward end-of-year awards and a ribbon is not provided). PVDA does not provide these special tests; the competitor must supply the test to the schooling show manager upon arrival at the show.
- 3. Repeat Tests:** The same horse/rider combination may enter and ride the same test twice but only the first ride will count toward placing in the class and in the PVDA Year End Awards. The second ride must be ridden hors concours unless a scratch can be filled in another arena in front of a different judge.
- 4. Riding before an Instructor/Coach Judge:** No rider may compete in classes before a judge from whom they have received instruction or coaching (with or without pay) within 30 days of the date of the show. Riding hors concours before that judge is permitted.
- 5. Submission of Entries:**
 - **Via PVDA Web Site:** Go to www.PVDA.org > Show Information. Click the *Online Registration Form* link on the right. This opens a form that you complete then pay via PayPal. The system verifies your membership and notifies the show manager. Email or snail mail a copy of your horse's Coggins to the show manager.
 - **Via Snail Mail:** Go to www.PVDA.org > Show Information. Under *Key 2012 PVDA Show Documents*, click *2012 PVDA Schooling Show Entry Form*. Print, complete, and sign the form. Mail (1) completed/signed form, (2) check made out to PVDA, (3) copy of Coggins, and (4) copy of your PVDA membership card to the person listed in this Omnibus. If you want your ride times mailed to you, enclose (5) a stamped, self-addressed envelope. Entries postmarked before the opening day will not be accepted.
 - **Other Entry Info:** Complete entries will take precedence over incomplete entries for scheduling and waiting list purposes. Entries with incorrect information or insufficient documentation will be accepted at the show manager's discretion. Telephone or email entries will not be accepted.
- 6. Show Scheduling:**
 - As many entrants as possible will be accommodated at each show; therefore, entries may be limited to two (2) rides per horse/rider combination, if necessary.
 - In the interest of time, lower level tests may be scheduled in a small arena.
- 7. Over-Subscribed Shows:**
 - First priority will be given to complete and timely entries from riders who have verified at least 8 hours of PVDA volunteer service performed by the rider within 12 months of the show date by either emailing or snail mailing a copy of their PVDA Volunteer Form(s). If the number of entries received with volunteer forms exceeds the show capacity, they will enter the lottery, but entries without volunteer forms will not.
 - Second priority will be given to complete and timely entries from riders who have **NOT**

verified at least 8 hours of PVDA volunteer service performed by the rider within 12 months of the show date. For these riders, if the show is over-subscribed, a lottery will be conducted to randomly and anonymously select entries to fill the show. The manager will conduct this lottery after the closing date.

8. **Fees:**

- **Ride Fees:** Ride fees are \$25 per ride for all tests except the Pas De Deux and Quadrille tests, for which the entry fees are \$15.00 per horse and rider combination.
- **Change Request Fee:** If changes are requested after the closing date, a \$5 handling fee per change may be charged.
- **Returned Checks or PayPal Refusal:** A fee of \$25 will be assessed for any returned check or PayPal refusal. This fee, along with the entry fees, must then be paid by cash, certified check, or money order. Failure may be subject to revocation of PVDA membership.

9. **Refunds:** Entry fees for scratches prior to the closing date will be refunded in full less any applicable PayPal fees. There will be no refunds for scratches after the closing date even if the time slot is filled from the waiting list. Members may not create their own waiting lists and replace riders without consent of the show manager. It is the sole responsibility of the show manager to fill scratches.

10. **Ride Times:** Ride times will be posted on the PVDA web site Monday before the show.

11. **Judges:** The Schooling Show Committee may change or substitute judges as necessary.

12. **Show Date/Location Changes:** Changes in show dates or locations will be announced in the PVDA Newsletter (check the Calendar of Events in each issue) and at www.PVDA.org. In the case of unforeseen circumstances (i.e., thunder and lightning) a show date may be canceled/rescheduled on short notice at the sole discretion of the facility owner. If the competitor is unable to show on the rescheduled date, entry fees will be refunded in full less any applicable PayPal fees.

13. **USEF Rules:** One of the purposes of PVDA Schooling Shows is to prepare the horse and rider for recognized competitions. USEF rules are enforced as closely as possible. The USEF Rule Book is available at <http://www.usef.org/contentPage2.aspx?id=ruleshome>.

14. **Show Attire:** Competitors are encouraged, but not required, to follow the USEF rules. However, as schooling shows are designed to be low-pressure competitions, show coats are encouraged but not required. A short- or long-sleeved white riding shirt with collar is permissible. Sleeveless shirts or T-shirts are not allowed. Riders may wear half-chaps, gaiters or leggings in solid black or brown, without fringe, matching the color of their boots, and made of smooth leather or leather-like material. Horses need not be braided.

Use of an ASTM/SEI certified safety helmet at all times while mounted is required.

15. **Score Ties:** In the event of a tie (equality of total points), the collective marks will determine the placings. If the totals of the collective marks for both riders are equal, both riders will receive the same placing and the next placing will not be awarded. If the totals of the collective marks for both riders are not equal, the rider with the higher collective marks will receive the higher placing.

16. **Non-Compete Horses:** If you intend to bring a young horse to expose it to a show environment without competing, you must clear this with the show manager prior to the show date. The decision will rest with the show manager. If permitted, you must have your current PVDA membership card and a current negative Coggins test with you at the show grounds to present when you arrive at the show grounds.

17. **Horse Safety:** General safety practices are to be observed at all times. Do not leave your horse unattended at or in the trailer at any time.

18. **Pets:** Dogs and other pets are not permitted on schooling show grounds at any time. You will be held liable for their interference and asked to remove them.

19. **Hold Harmless:** Neither PVDA nor the landowner shall be held responsible for any injury, damage, nor loss to exhibitors, spectators, horses, or property of exhibitors or spectators.

20. **Failure to Comply:** Failure to comply with show rules may result in loss of privileges.

Schooling Show Etiquette

1. Be courteous to all competitors and show volunteers.
2. Do not lunge horses in the middle of warm up areas; instead, use out of the way areas and yield to riders preparing to ride their tests.
3. Pass left shoulder to left shoulder in the warm up area and yield to those traveling at faster gaits.
4. Leave your trailer site clean. Pick up trash and manure before leaving. Take your manure home with you.
5. Remember that sites are donated by property owners. Do not do anything that may result in damage to their property. Please observe facility rules.

Dressage Seat Equitation

1. This class will be offered at all PVDA Schooling Shows.
2. Equitation Class rules are in USEF DR132 Dressage Seat Equitation.
3. Dressage Seat Equitation classes may be offered for Juniors, Young Riders and Adults according to the following specifications:
 - Medium walk, working trot, and canter both ways of the ring must be performed. The rider's position, seat, and correct use and effect of the aids required by the Training and First Level Dressage tests are to be judged.
 - The movements shall be performed by the exhibitors simultaneously; however, the judge may ask for independent tests.
 - No change of horses shall be required.
 - Whips and spurs are allowed. Horses shall be shown in plain snaffle.

Hold Harmless Clause

Understanding that horse sports may be hazardous and dangerous, even leading to permanent injury or death, each owner, rider, spectator, and other participant assumes any and all risk of loss or injury and agrees to hold harmless, regardless of negligent acts or omissions, the Potomac Valley Dressage Association, Inc., organizer, show committee, and all horse show personnel.

Chapter Challenge General Rules

1. **Eligibility:**

- Only PVDA members who are also members of a PVDA chapter may ride in the Chapter Challenge.
- Determination of who rides on the teams is at the discretion of the chapter. Every chapter member has the right to participate in this team competition, and no distinction is made between amateur, novice, or professional.
- Only one team per chapter per Challenge Class is allowed. See information for Class 16 (MFS) and Class 18 (Pas de Deux, and Quadrille) teams below.
- The same horse/rider combination may only ride in one Challenge Class plus Class 16 (Musical Freestyle) and Class 18 (Pas de Deux and Quadrille) at the same level or one level lower or higher. The horse or the rider in a different combination (another horse or rider combination) may compete in another Challenge Class.

2. **Warm-Up Classes:** Riders riding in a Warm-Up Class must also be a member of a chapter team riding in the corresponding Challenge Class. Warm-up class scores do not count toward the Challenge awards. There is no requirement to ride in a warm-up class.

3. **Challenge Classes:** Challenge Classes are ridden by teams. A team consists of three or four members of a chapter riding the same test, with the following exceptions:

- **Classes 13 and 14 (Second Level and Above TOC).** Riders on a team may each ride a different test at Second through Fourth Levels. The warm-up ride will be the next lower test, i.e., Second 1 Warm-Up Ride and Second 2 Challenge Ride.
- **Class 16 (PVDA Training through USEF 4th Level MFS).** A team consists of two to four individual freestyles; the freestyles may be at different levels from PVDA Training through USDF Fourth Levels. Submit a CD of the music to the show secretary.
- **Class 18 (Pas de Deux and Quadrille).** A Pas de Deux / Quadrille team may have one to four entries (one to four sets of Pas de Deux or Quadrille riders). Different level Quadrille and Pas de Deux tests may be ridden.

5. **Challenge Class Scoring:** The three highest scores of each team in a Challenge Class will be added together to determine the placing of the Challenge Classes, with the exception of Class 16 (Musical Freestyle) and Class 18 (Pas de Deux and Quadrille). In these classes, if there are four entries on a team, the lowest score is dropped and the remaining scores averaged; otherwise, all scores for a team in these classes are averaged.

7. **Scores for PVDA Awards:** Chapter Challenge scores do not count toward PVDA Annual High Score Awards or the Rider Achievement Awards.

8. **Show Attire:** This competition is not recognized by USEF or USDF; however, USEF rules will be in effect at this competition, including attire requirements. **Use of an ASTM/SEI certified safety helmet at all times while mounted is required.**

9. **Volunteers:** For their entries to be accepted, each chapter must supply the show with a minimum of **one volunteer per team**. The Chapter Chair should contact the Entry Secretary with volunteer names and telephone numbers by the closing date. Chapter Chairs can also contact the Show Manager to sign up for pre-show volunteer jobs well in advance. Setting up and taking down the rings (before and after the show) each count as two volunteers.

Chapter Challenge Entry Fees
